Digital Expressions

A group exhibition of emerging digital artists and designers from the United States, Europe, and Asia took place at Galapagos Art Space from November 13 to 15, 2003. This exhibition explored the intersection of interaction, expression and technology and was part of the International Chopin and Friends Festival organized by New York Dance & Arts Innovations. Digital technology is a powerful, yet vastly unexplored artistic medium.
